Its new design is turning heads. That's because Pradi's new motor bike is no bunch of crock. That's because Pradi, from northern India, put his heart and soul into building a bike that looks like a crocodile.

I bought the motorcycle for 3000 rupees a year and a half ago. The customisation cost me 45,000 rupees. Its taken me more than 8 months to design this motorcycle.

He built it to ferry his friends and family around but its actually a good form of transport too. It can seat as many as ten people and in a country where fuel efficiency is the first thing buyers look at, Pradi's crocodile is a frugal one.

The bike gives 35km to a litre. It goes to a top speed of 50 kilometres per hour and can seat ten people.

Its not really an easy ride for the passengers though, they have to move the opposite way when it turns so it doesn't tip up.
